- Walk with us in the parade. Sunday. Gather between 11—11:30 P.M.

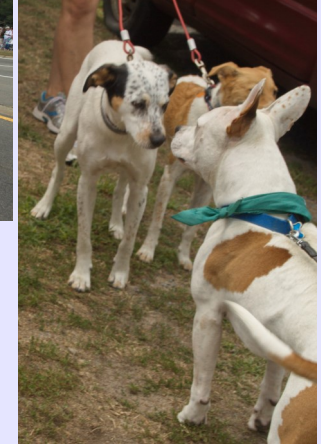
Windmill Weekend—EDOA participation

- Float setup is earlier. Come early and lend a hand.

- It is only about 1 mile to the Windmill Green.
- The early weather report is for a partly cloudy day, no rain and mid-70's temps. Perfect!
- Bring water, poop bags and a leash. (we will have extras if needed).
- You will be provided with "gift bags" to share along the parade route; candy for the kids and dogs treats.
- The theme of Windmill Weekend is "Once Upon a Time". Our float will reflect that.
- Feel free to dress up yourself or your dog. It is real cute.
